Thank you for helping us celebrate Maggie's love of life and children, working together to find cures for pediatric cancers, and helping families with children affected.

THANK YOU FOR BEING PART OF MAGGIE'S MISSION.

I have had the honor and pleasure of attending this gala and celebration of Maggie for years. Though I am disappointed that I am not able to be with you tonight, I know it will be another powerful and meaningful event.

As a pediatric oncologist and cancer biologist, I work to develop treatments that maximize the success of currently available medicines, and to ultimately devise new therapies that are precise, curative, and safe. Your support plays a vital role in understanding the causes of childhood cancer, including the kind that Maggie had, and using this essential knowledge to develop effective therapies. I am excited to share three breakthroughs that would not have been possible without you and Maggie's Mission.

FIRST

Based on research supported by Maggie's Mission, together with clinical investigators at MSK Kids, we developed a new clinical trial of the recently developed experimental drug called elimusertib, to establish its safe use in children with cancers, including rhabdoid tumors in particular.

This study is actively enrolling patients across the entire country. We anticipate completing this trial in 2024, which would allow us to combine this new drug with other drugs in order to develop effective therapies, which are so urgently needed.

SECOND

We constructed precise molecular maps of rhabdoid tumors, the type of childhood cancer Maggie had. Besides being the most complete maps of rhabdoid tumors to date, these results are also beginning to reveal candidate targets for new immunotherapies that are fundamentally different from all other treatments. We have begun to test these targets with the goal of advancing them for medical development for patients.

LASTLY

Maggie's Mission and your support enabled us to determine how rhabdoid tumors respond to a recently approved new drug called Tazemetostat (Tazverik®), which works for some patients with rhabdoid tumors but not for others. We defined the molecular principles that explain how Tazemetostat works, pointing to two new combination treatments that should be more effective. We have already begun discussions with pharmaceutical companies to develop a new combination clinical trial.

We are confident that continued research will one day lead to effective treatments for children with cancer like Maggie's and many others.






